- 2017 – Year of Coronation of Our Lady of Rosary
In November 2016 the Senate adopted a resolution establishing the 2017 as Year of Coronation of Our Lady of Rosary (*Czestochowa*), the Queen of the Polish Crown. The main jubilee celebrations with the participation of the church and state authorities took place on 26 August 2017.
- Religious action “Rosary at the Borders” 7 October 2017
“Rosary at the Borders” took place in 320 churches near Poland’s border and 4,000 so-called prayer zones, including the biggest international airport in Poland. The event was organised by a lay organization called the Solo Dios Basta Foundation. The main goal for this event was to pray for peace for Poland and the whole world.
- Anti-abortion law
Ruling party made draft law a near-total abortion ban (There has also been a law change so that the morning-after pill is now only available by prescription). A dozen of NGO’s are collecting signatures to introduce a draft bill for the liberalisation of abortion laws.

- Decision of Porto's Court: Process [n.º 355/15.2 GAFLG.P1](#) on woman's adultery. In this written ruling, the judges said that adultery is “a very serious offense against a man's honor and dignity”. They also quoted the Bible saying that, according to the sacred text, an adulterous woman should be punished by death and, finally, cited a 1886 Portuguese law that gave only symbolic sentences to men who killed their wives for suspected adultery (October, 2017).

This project of law recognizes the right to gender self-determination, namely of transsexual individuals, from the age of sixteen. - Le 17 juillet 2017, la Chambre d'appel de la Cour Suprême de Russie a confirmé la décision du 20 avril 2017 de la Cour Suprême, selon laquelle le Centre dirigeant des Témoins de Jéhovas de Russie et 395 organisations locales des Témoins de Jéhovas, enregistrés comme personnes morales sont reconnues comme des organisations extrémistes et dissolues ([voir la lettre d'information de mai 2017](#)).

- On November 2, 2017 the Supreme Court of Canada ruled that the [Charter of Rights and Freedoms](#) can not be invoked to protect the mountainous land considered sacred by the people of the Ktunaxa Nation, an Indigenous group living in British Columbia. The ruling will allow a ski resort to be built on Jumbo Mountain.
- On October 18, 2017 the province of Québec adopted [Bill n°62](#), titled “An Act to foster adherence to State religious neutrality and, in particular, to provide a framework for requests for accommodations on religious grounds in certain bodies.” The purpose of this law is to ensure religious neutrality in the giving and receiving of public services. The law restricts citizens who work in the public service and those who receive public services from wearing clothing obstructing the face.
