- An amendment of the Religious Denominations Act in force since 1 January 2019. Published in *Darzhaven vestnik* [State Gazette], No. 108, 29 December 2018. The text is available in Bulgarian at: <https://lex.bg/laws/ldoc/2135462355>
The major change in the bill concerns the state subsidies for religious denominations in Article 28. The amendment introduces new rules for the estimation of the state subsidies. It distinguishes between the denominations which adherents count more than one per cent of the Bulgarian population and those who war below (para 2). The denominations from the first group receive 10 levs (5 euro) for every Bulgarian citizen who has register him/herself as belonging to the corresponding religious tradition. In addition, this subsidy cannot be below 15 million levs (7,5 million euro) (para 3). While the denominations with smaller membership will receive subsidies individually determined for each of them by the state authorities. No information about the rules for their estimation is provided. This means that only the Orthodox and the Muslim religious institutions will be the main beneficiaries. As 4,373,135 Bulgarian citizens registered themselves as Orthodox in 2011, the Bulgarian Orthodox Church is expected to receive an annual subsidy for 2019 of about 44 million levs (22 million euro). In its turn the Chief Mufti’s Office, which adherents counted 577,139 in 2011, has to receive 15 million levs (7,5 euro), as the amount of a subsidy estimated on the grounds of formula 10 levs per believer is below the minimum of 15 million levs.

- An amendment of the Religious Denomination Act registered under No. 954-01-4 on 31 January 2019. Originally aimed to release the Chief Mufti's Office of its debts of over 8 million leva (i.e. over 4 million euro), regarded as an obstacle for the transfer of the state subsidy to the main Muslim religious institution in the country, the amendment was edited under the pressure of the negative reactions of society. As a result, the parliament voted a deferment of the debt. The second reading of the amendments is voted by the National Assembly and is waiting the approval of the President. Dispone che in caso di pubblicazione della presente ordinanza siano omissi i riferimenti ai nominativi o ad altri dati identificativi delle parti. »

(consta nella lesione della reputazione di un soggetto (persona fisica, giuridica o anche associazione di più soggetti comunque organizzati collettivamente) che sia individuato o comunque individuabile, sicché dichiarazioni concernenti l'omosessualità in genere non assumono carattere di concreta offensività giuridica di uno o più soggetti, potendosi ascrivere a comportamenti praticabili da un numero potenzialmente illimitato di persone; per contro, dichiarazioni che attribuiscono al "movimento lgbt" la intenzione di "diffondere la pedofilia" riguardano una categoria determinata di soggetti e hanno dunque quel carattere di concreta offensività che impone di riconoscere la sussistenza dell'elemento oggettivo del reato. È risarcibile il danno non patrimoniale subito dalle associazioni di categoria costituitesi parte civile. »

- *McKitty v. Hayani* 2018 ONSC 4015 – presently awaiting ruling from the Ontario Court of Appeal, this case centers on the question of if the religious beliefs of a woman who believes death is determined with the cessation of heartbeat could be taken over a medical practitioner's declaration of brain death
- The Quebec superior court has authorized a class-action lawsuit by current and former Jehovah's Witnesses against the religion's main legal entity over allegations they covered up sexual abuse of minors
- Alberta's Bill 24, preventing religious schools from informing parents that their child is a member of a gay-straight alliance, is being challenged by conservative politicians in the province.
- Quebec has proposed Bill 21, which would prevent public sector workers like teachers, police officers, and judges from wearing any visible religious symbols. Protests are currently ongoing, and it is expected to be challenged if passed.
